Coronation of King Charles III

In King Charles' first Christmas speech, he talked about the faith in people that his mother had and how would want to echo this during his reign:

"It is a belief in the extraordinary ability of each person to touch, with goodness and compassion, the lives of others, and to shine a light in the world around them.

This is the essence of our community and the very foundation of our society.

... So, whatever faith you have, or whether you have none, it is in this life-giving light, and with the true humility that lies in our service to others, that I believe we can find hope for the future."

As part of this sentiment, to mark the King's Coronation we are creating our own version of 'The Big Lunch' and 'The Big Help Out'.

On Wednesday 24th May, we will be organising an afternoon to get our community together. Saplings, Ash, Holly, Elm, Oak and Poplar will be organising 'Stay and Play' type sessions, Beech, Rowan and Willow will be organising class-based sessions for parents to join and Blossom, Chestnut, Maple and Sycamore will be hosting a café in the hall for parents to visit. Parents from all classes are welcome to visit the hall for refreshments during the afternoon.
